



LOCATING UNIVERSITY OF ARKANSAS RECITAL RECORDINGS

The Performing Arts and Media Department of Mullins Library houses selected recordings of the University of Arkansas Department of Music concerts. Recital recordings are available since 1985 and are in a variety of formats. Access to information on the recordings is available on InfoLinks. Corresponding programs for the concerts may be found in **MEDIA REF** and the Special Collection Department (ML 42 .F38 U87). Concert recordings may not be checked out for home or office use but may be used in the Performing Arts and Media Department. Facilities are available to burn or rip the recordings to various media.

You may locate a concert recording using a number of search strategies. A complete listing of recordings is available under the title "Concert recording." You may also locate recordings by date of performance, composer or title of composition, individual performer or ensemble, type of recital or ensemble instrumentation, and concert series title.

Locating Recordings by Date

Recordings are listed by the date of the recording. A typical call number consists of initial letters which refer to the type of media (CCT = concert audiotope, CCV = concert videotape or DVD, and CCD = concert compact disc) followed by a six digit number referring to the year, month and date of the recital. To search a call number *click* on **Number Searches** and then *click* on **Local Call #**.

Ex. A concert performed and recorded on a CD on April 5, 2006 will be listed as CCD 060405

Ex. An opera performed and videotaped on April 5, 1999 will be listed as CCV 990405

Locating Recordings by Performer or Ensemble

Individuals who perform in a recital are indexed in the library catalog. When doing an **Author** search, type the individual's name LAST NAME, FIRST NAME. The performer's primary instrument or role in the concert is listed after the name.

Ex. Greeson, James, guitar.
Greeson, James, conductor.

All university sponsored ensembles are listed under "University of Arkansas, Fayetteville." followed by the name of the ensemble. Recordings by ensembles can be located using an **Author** search.

Ex. University of Arkansas, Fayetteville. Schola Cantorum.
Ex. University of Arkansas, Fayetteville. University Symphony Orchestra.

Locating Recordings by Composer or Title of Composition

Composer names and titles of individual compositions performed in a recital can be located by using a **Keyword** search. As information on proper names and titles are taken from the concert programs, variations in names may occur (e.g., W. A. Mozart, Wolfgang A. Mozart, or Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart).

Locating Recordings by Recital Type.

By performing a **Subject** search on the recital type, i.e. flute recital, faculty recital, composition recital, chamber music recital, you can obtain a listing of all recitals featuring University of Arkansas faculty, original compositions, or recital music performed by specific instruments. A **TITLE** search will locate all recitals that are part of a series such as the Wednesday recital hour, or the Sunday Showcase Concert Series.
